Dear Mt. Lehman Families,





Please look for Tear-Down at the second to last volunteer sign-up spot. It is only for 1 hour and it would make such a difference if many parents signed-up, making this task easier.



This fundraiser provides the greatest amount of revenue for our school and community each year and its success is dependent on all of us helping out.






On September 29th is a Professional Development Day where teachers will be learning about teaching Truth and Reconciliation. Students will not be in attendance for the day.




# **Attention Parents: PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF**

Please review the following important safety rules and please help us keep all our children safe by following these rules every day, even when you are in a hurry.

- Drop-off and Pick-up. Please drop-off your children in the drop-off zone in the morning and after school if you can't find parking.
- Students who cannot get out of the vehicle on their own should not use the drop-off and pick-up zone.
- The Pick-up and drop-off zone is constantly moving, and vehicles cannot be parked while parents help their children.

NO parking in the drop-off /pick-up zone. Your vehicle should remain on, and your children will meet you in the pick-up and drop-off zone.

- · Please drive to the far end of the zone, so more cars can fit in the drop-off/pick-up zone.
- Do not leave the drop off zone until it is your turn to exit (we want to avoid collision and congestion)
- · If your children are not present, loop around the zone again and Ms. Lincoln or a staff member will find your children for you.
- · If your child does not feel comfortable walking to the pick-up and drop-off zone you will have to park and walk in.
- You can park in the school parking lots, on the street, or the Community Hall.
- Students are not permitted to be crossing the drop-off and pick-up zone/parking lot without a adult. It is a very heavy traffic zone even though it is an elementary school parking lot.








