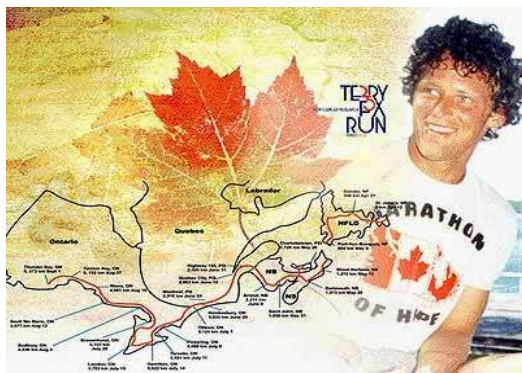

Attention Parents: PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF

Please review the following important safety rules and please help us keep all our children safe by following these rules every day, even when you are in a hurry.

- Drop-off and Pick-up: Please drop off your children in the drop-off zone in the morning and after school if you can't find parking.
- Students who cannot get out of the vehicle on their own should not use the drop-off and pick-up zone.
- The Pick-up and drop-off zone is constantly moving, and vehicles cannot be parked while parents help their children.

NO parking in the drop-off /pick-up zone. Your vehicle should remain on, and your children will meet you in the pick-up and drop-off zone.

- Please drive to the far end of the zone, so more cars can fit in the drop-off/pick-up zone.
- Do not leave the drop off zone until it is your turn to exit (we want to avoid collision and congestion)
- If your children are not present, loop around the zone again and Ms. Lincoln or a staff member will find your children for you.
- If your child does not feel comfortable walking to the pick-up and drop-off zone you will have to park and walk in.
- You can park in the school parking lots, on the street, or the Community Hall.
- Students are not permitted to cross the drop-off and pick-up zone/parking lot without a adult. It is a very heavy traffic zone even though it is an elementary school parking lot.
